Website Privacy Policy

CD Nutrition LLC ("CD Nutrition," "we," "us," or "our") respects your privacy. This Website Privacy Policy explains how we collect, use, disclose, and protect information collected through our public website, cdnutritionllc.com (the "Website"). It applies to information collected through the Website and does not replace our HIPAA Notice of Privacy Practices or policies that apply to clients receiving nutrition services.

1. Information We Collect

We may collect information you voluntarily provide through the Website, including your name, email address, telephone number, and the contents of messages or other information you choose to submit. We may also collect limited technical information automatically, such as IP address, browser type, device type, operating system, referring website, pages viewed, and approximate date and time of Website activity, depending on the Website's hosting, security, and analytics configuration.

2. How We Use Information

We may use Website information to respond to inquiries, provide information about our services, communicate with prospective clients, respond to requests to schedule or learn more about services, maintain and secure the Website, troubleshoot technical issues, understand Website use, and comply with legal obligations.

3. Contact Form

The Website includes a contact form requesting your name, email address, and phone number. The form is intended for general inquiries and initial communication about services. Please do not submit detailed medical information, diagnoses, treatment information, insurance identification numbers, or other sensitive health information through the public Website contact form. When appropriate, CD Nutrition may direct prospective or existing clients to a secure patient portal or other appropriate communication method for information related to nutrition services.

4. Health Information and HIPAA

Information submitted through the public Website is not necessarily handled in the same manner as information maintained as part of a client's health-care record. When you become a client, information related to your nutrition services may be subject to HIPAA and CD Nutrition's Notice of Privacy Practices. The Notice of Privacy Practices governs CD Nutrition's use and disclosure of protected health information in its role as a health-care provider.

5. Service Providers and Third Parties

We may use third-party service providers to host, maintain, secure, operate, analyze, or support the Website and its functions. These providers may process information on our behalf as necessary to provide their services. Categories may include website hosting providers, form or communication providers, technology and security providers, analytics providers, and professional or administrative service providers. We do not sell personal information collected through the Website.

6. Cookies and Similar Technologies

The Website may use cookies, pixels, analytics tools, or similar technologies depending on the Website's configuration. These technologies may be used to operate the Website, remember preferences, maintain security, understand Website traffic, and improve Website performance. The specific technologies in use may change over time. You can generally adjust cookie settings through your browser, although disabling certain technologies may affect Website functionality.

7. Online Tracking and Do Not Track

The Website may permit third-party technology providers to collect information about Website activity as described above. CD Nutrition does not currently use Website-collected personal information for targeted advertising and does not sell Website-collected personal information. As of the effective date of this policy, the Website does not respond to browser “Do Not Track” signals as a separate mechanism. If our practices change, this policy will be updated as appropriate.

8. How We Share Information

We may disclose Website information to service providers and contractors that help us operate the Website or provide related administrative, technical, or professional services; when required by law, legal process, or governmental request; to protect the rights, safety, or security of CD Nutrition, Website users, or others; or in connection with a business transaction such as a merger, acquisition, restructuring, or sale of assets. We do not sell personal information collected through the Website.

9. Data Security

We use reasonable administrative, technical, and physical safeguards appropriate to the information we maintain. However, no Website, electronic transmission, or storage system can be guaranteed to be completely secure. You should avoid submitting sensitive health or financial information through a public Website form.

10. Data Retention

We retain Website information for as long as reasonably necessary for the purposes for which it was collected, including responding to inquiries, maintaining business records, complying with legal obligations, resolving disputes, and protecting our rights. Retention periods may vary depending on the type of information and the circumstances in which it was collected.

11. Your Privacy Rights

Depending on applicable law, you may have rights regarding certain personal information, including rights to request access to, correction of, or deletion of certain information, subject to applicable exceptions. You may also have rights concerning certain types of data processing. To make a privacy request, contact CD Nutrition using the contact information below. We may need to verify your identity before completing a request. If applicable law provides an appeal process for a denied privacy request, we will provide information about that process when responding to the request.

12. How to Request Access or Correction

Please do not include sensitive health information in an initial email or public Website form unless we have directed you to use that method. For client health information, we may direct you to the secure process used for your client records.

13. Children’s Privacy

The Website is intended for adults and is not directed to children under 13. We do not knowingly collect personal information through the Website from children under 13. If you believe a child has provided personal information through the Website, please contact us so we can review and address the information appropriately.

14. Links to Other Websites

The Website may contain links to third-party websites or services. Those websites have their own privacy practices and policies. CD Nutrition is not responsible for the privacy, security, or content practices of third-party websites.

15. Changes to This Policy

We may update this Website Privacy Policy from time to time to reflect changes in our Website, business practices, technology, or applicable legal requirements. When we make material changes, we will update the effective date and

post the revised policy on the Website. Your continued use of the Website after an updated policy is posted means the updated policy applies to information collected thereafter, subject to applicable law.
